Old Business:

New Business:

Visit by the Provost/Academic Vice-President:

Provost/AVP John Day e-mailed Bob Kolesar on August 28, suggesting some "questions for Faculty consideration" this year. His list included "FYS, Faculty Handbook, clinical faculty, health benefits," and he ended with a more general question: "Does the Handbook adequately articulate the rights and responsibilities of the Faculty?" The Faculty Handbook Committee thought that it would be a good idea to have a discussion with the Provost/AVP about these issues. Bob will issue an invitation to John Day to attend our next meeting.
